




### Health Note: COVID-19

#### What you need to know about Coronavirus disease (COVID-19)

Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) is a respiratory illness that can be spread from person to person. If you are sick you must separate yourself from other people and animals in your home stay in a specific area of your home and if possible, use a separate bathroom, also don't handle any animals in the home.

What to look for with this disease:

- \*fever
- \*cough
- \*shortness of breath



#### These symptoms may not show for 2-14 days after exposure

If you develop symptoms such as fever, cough, and/or difficulty breathing, and have been in close contact with a person known to have COVID-19 or have recently traveled from an area with ongoing spread of COVID-19, stay home and call your healthcare provider. Older patients and individuals who have severe underlying medical conditions or are immunocompromised should contact their healthcare provider early, even if their illness is mild. If you have severe symptoms, such as persistent pain or pressure in the chest, new confusion or inability to arouse, or bluish lips of face, contact your healthcare provider or emergency room and seek care immediately. Your doctor will determine if you have signs and symptoms of COVID-19 and whether you should be tested and or if you should be quarantined.

### Health Note: COVID-19 (cont.)

Based upon information to date, those most at risk for more serious complications from COVID-19 are:

- People 65 years and older
- People who live in a nursing home or long-term care facility
- People of any age with the following underlying medical conditions
  - Chronic lung disease or asthma
  - Congestive heart failure or coronary artery disease
  - Diabetes
  - Neurologic conditions that weaken ability to cough
  - Weakened immune system
  - Chemotherapy or radiation for cancer (currently or in recent past)
  - Sickle cell anemia
  - Chronic kidney disease requiring dialysis
  - Cirrhosis of the liver
  - Lack of spleen or a spleen that doesn't function correctly
  - Extreme obesity (body mass index [BMI]  $\geq 40$ )
  - People who are pregnant



Practice everyday preventive actions to help reduce your risk of getting sick and remind others also

- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Stay home when you are sick, except to get medical care.
- Cover your coughs and sneezes with a tissue and throw the tissue in the trash.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing; going to the bathroom; and before eating or preparing food.
- If soap and water are not readily available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol. Always wash hands with soap and water if hands are visibly dirty.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces and objects (e.g., tables, countertops, light switches, doorknobs, and cabinet handles).
